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# GRANT OPPORTUNITY AND PROJECT CATEGORIES

At Apex Digital Solutions, we empower organizations to confidently navigate change, strengthen security, and get the most value from their technology investments. In honor of this, we are excited to announce the launch of the Apex Digital Technology Empowerment Grant, a new service-based grant opportunity.

Apex Digital will select one eligible 501(c)(3) nonprofit to provide up to \$25,000 worth of services or solutions to drive meaningful, lasting improvements to their technology environment.

There are several ways to put the Apex Digital Technology Empowerment Grant to work. Applicants must be seeking a grant in one of the following project categories offered by Apex Digital:



- 1. **Identify:** Microsoft 365 Assessments and Health Checks This is a foundational step for any organization looking to get the most out of this platform and take the first step towards a more modern and secure environment. This service is designed to evaluate your current Microsoft 365 environment and uncover opportunities to improve performance, security, and usability.
  - We provide a comprehensive review of your existing configuration, including (but not limited to) Exchange, Entra ID, Teams, OneDrive, Intune, and Defender.
  - These assessments uncover misconfigurations or inefficiencies that, once addressed, can significantly enhance your team's productivity and reduce long-term risks.
  - Based on the assessment and the specific needs of the selected grantee, there may be remaining service hours to support implementation of key recommendations.
- 2. **Design: Strategic Planning and Technology Road Mapping** We often see nonprofits struggling with aging or patched-together infrastructure. This service offering identifies those pain points and lays the groundwork for modernization efforts.
  - Our Strategic Planning engagements begin with a discovery phase that combines a lightweight assessment to understand your organization's goals, challenges, and current IT state.
  - Based on those findings, we build a custom roadmap that includes infrastructure and security recommendations with a strong emphasis on cloud-readiness.
- 3. **Execute: Deployment and Migrations** Many nonprofits reach a point where they know it's time to modernize, but realizing that change can present roadblocks, including a lack of internal expertise, the scale and complexity of the work, and the challenge of minimizing disruption for end users. That is where our Deployment and Migration projects come in. These services turn your strategic plans into reality. We support a range of deployment and migration needs, including:
  - Microsoft Teams Phone Deployment Transition from traditional phone systems to Teams Phone for more flexible and cost-effective communication.
  - On-Prem to Cloud Migrations Migrate email, file servers, and SharePoint to the cloud to increase scalability, security, and accessibility.
  - Microsoft Intune and Cloud Device Management Onboard, configure, and secure devices through policy setup, patching, and cloud-based management tools.



- 4. Launch: Physical Setup of Space/Devices Do you have equipment for a community computer lab, collaborative workspace, or training room, but lack the hands-on support needed to set up physical workspaces and devices? Our Setup projects focus on wiring, configuration, and getting hardware operational so your team and community can get to work right away.
- 5. **Other Proposed Project Types:** Applicants are welcome to propose other service-based projects that align with Apex Digital's capabilities and its organization's goals. Apex Digital reserves the right to decline any proposals that fall outside of their standard business offerings.

**NOTE:** Grant funding does not cover hardware or licensing. Organizations must have the necessary hardware and licenses already in place or be prepared to purchase them separately outside of the grant. Apex Digital can assist with hardware and license purchasing if requested.

Successful applicants will be able to articulate how this service-based grant and partnership will help advance their mission and/or be leveraged to support a specific strategic initiative.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

# General Organization Requirements

- Michigan-based headquarters and serving residents in counties located in Southeast Michigan (Wayne, Oakland, Macomb, or Washtenaw counties).
- Must be a 501(c)3 in good standing with the State of Michigan and the Internal Revenue Service. Applicants will be required to upload a copy of their IRS designation letter, 990 form, W-9, financial statements, and Michigan Solicitation License.
- 50+ employees
- Must demonstrate \$15M+ in annual revenue.
- Exclusions: hospital systems and schools

#### **Technical Environment Requirements**

- IT team size of at least one person
- Must use Microsoft 365, Office 365, or Teams
